

# Venezuela and the German War

May the kidnapping of Venezuelan President Maduro have been a military coup by the United States: either the armed people rule over the riches of a country, or the robbers and looters of this world descend upon them. Mobilisation in our own country does not end with outrage at Mr. Trump, who is merely the expression of an exploitative order that humanity must put an end to before it has nothing left to live for.

Here, on our own doorstep, war is being produced. The strike, as a first step towards putting an end to the profit that fuels war, is true international solidarity. The blockade of war transports. The fight against war mobilisation, which will bury the constitution and conscientious objection as quickly as calm continues to reign in this country, but half of Europe is on the streets.
